



WHAT DOES BEING A “MEMBER” OF THE ANDOVER SENIOR CENTER

MEAN BESIDES ENJOYING THE PROGRAM AND BENEFITS OF MEMBERSHIP?

It means that as a member, you have a vested interest in seeing that the center is used in a beneficial way to both members and the community. Ways that you can (and are) doing this is by participating in activities helping out with simple chores such as dishes after lunch, changing a light bulb and being personally responsible for picking up after yourself and others after activities. Volunteering to do specific duties such as cooking meals, leading an activity or working an event are things that will make the operation of the Center more cost effective and allow us to offer more varied activities that all can enjoy. There are lots of opportunities to help have a good time!

INFORMATION FOR ASC HOME BOUND MEAL DELIVERY

The home-bound meal delivery is intended for those that are physically unable to shop and prepare their own meals. The Andover Home Bound Meal Service is to provide a lunch-time meal, Monday thru Friday, for those living within the Andover City limits. These meals are delivered by volunteers.

Those who meet this criteria, may sign up on a regular basis for receiving meals every day Monday thru Friday, or on a temporary basis, such as returning home from a hospital stay or the temporary absence of a caregiver.

If the participant signs up to receive a meal on a regular basis, but there is a day they do not want/need a meal, they may call the Center before 10:00 am to cancel the meal that day. If this call is received by 10:00 am they will not need to pay.

Meals are delivered between 11:45 am and 1:00 pm. Recipients must be home at time of delivery. If they are not, meals will not be left at the home and the meal must still be paid for. Each recipient is asked to provide their phone number as well as an alternate contact person's phone number.

The suggested donation is \$5 for each meal. If this is a hardship for some, other arrangements must be made by calling the Center Director. Each recipient has received information concerning the service and the forms must be filled out and returned. To ensure continued deliveries, the sign up sheet each participant received in December from the delivery drivers, must be filled out and returned asap. If not received by January 31st, we will assume you are no longer in need of the delivered meals.

As a reminder, **in case of inclement weather**, the Center follows the Andover School District on school closings which are available through local news channels. If the school district closes, the Center will also be closed.
