







The Andover Senior Center (ASC) is committed to maintaining an important service to the Andover area by providing daily meals during the week to home-bound residents who qualify for the service. The meals are delivered by Volunteer Drivers using their personal vehicles.

With safety and security in mind, Volunteer Drivers will need to meet the following requirements.

Provide a copy of the following to the Director for file retention:

A copy of a valid driver's license.

Evidence of vehicle insurance coverage on all vehicles they will use for delivery purposes.

Notify the Director of any changes to these documents.

\*\* The Director will ensure these documents are secured and will destroy or return them when Volunteer no longer serves as a delivery driver.

Volunteer must read and agree to the ASC Code of Conduct.

Volunteer is hereby informed they are not to enter the residence during delivery.

Volunteer should notify the Director as soon as possible if unable to drive on their selected/assigned day. If the Volunteer is ill, they should not delivery meals. The Director will arrange for a substitute driver as needed

By signing this document, volunteers are acknowledging they are responsible for any vehicle accidents that may occur during the delivery of meals.
