ORDINANCE NO. 1829

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1812 OF THE CITY OF  
ANDOVER, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Andover, Kansas (the “City”) has heretofore by Resolution No. 21-27 adopted October 12, 2021, and published in the City’s official newspaper as required by law on October 23, 2021, as amended by Resolution No. 22-06 adopted March 29, 2022, and to be published April 9, 2022, (collectively, the “Authorizing Resolution”), found and determined it to be advisable and authorized the making of Heritage Second Addition Water Improvements, Heritage Second Addition Sewer Improvements, Heritage Second Addition Paving Improvements, Heritage Second Addition Paving (Alley) Improvements (collectively herein, the “Improvements”) in the City, as provided by K.S.A. 12-6a01 *et seq.*, as amended and supplemented, at a total estimated cost of \$1,957,000, a portion of which costs will be levied and assessed against properties benefitting from the Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City finds and determines it advisable to amend Ordinance No. 1812 of the City adopted October 12, 2021, and published in the City’s official newspaper as required by law on October 23, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment to Recitals of Ordinance No. 1812. The first and second recitals of Ordinance No. 1812, are hereby amended by replacing them with the following:

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Andover, Kansas (the “City”) has heretofore by Resolution No. 21-27, as amended by Resolution No. 22-06 (collectively, the “Authorizing Resolution”), found and determined it to be advisable and authorized the making of certain Heritage Second Addition Water Improvements, Heritage Second Addition Sewer Improvements, Heritage Second Addition Paving Improvements, Heritage Second Addition Paving (Alley) Improvements (collectively, the “Improvements”) in the City, as provided by K.S.A. 12-6a01 *et seq.*, as amended and supplemented, at a total estimated cost of \$1,957,000 (said cost may be increased to include temporary interest or finance costs incurred during the course of design and construction of the project, and also may be increased at the rate of 1% per month from and after March 29, 2022), which costs will be levied and assessed against properties benefiting from the Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City, upon an examination thereof, has considered and found and determined certain subject petitions filed on October 4, 2021, as modified with the amended petition for the Heritage Second Addition

Paving Improvements filed on October 1, 2021 (collectively, the “Petitions”) to be sufficient, having been signed by the owners of record, whether resident or not, of all property liable for assessment for the costs of the Improvements; and

Section 2. Amending Ordinance. This ordinance supplements and amends Ordinance No. 1812, only to the extent necessary to reflect the receipt of the revised petition reflecting a change in the scope of the project for the Heritage Second Addition Paving improvements. Except to the extent specifically amended hereby, Ordinance No. 1812, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the governing body of the City of Andover, Kansas and its publication in the official newspaper of the City.
