



HONORARY MEMBER - RUTH HELENA

Ruth Ella Warne was born on April 19, 1928 south of Wichita, KS on seven acres of land beside the Arkansas River. She was sixth of seven children, with three brothers and three sisters. Ruth met Melvin Helena at a dance club and dated only six months before marrying in 1948.

They moved to Andover in April, 1952 and she is still in the same house. They raised three boys and one girl, and she now has eleven grandchildren, 2 great grandchildren and one great, great grandchild! Together they owned and operated the Helena Nursery until it closed in 2011. They donated their remaining stock to the zoo and Plant Kingdom. Ruth babysat for about 100 children in this area and still keeps in touch with many of them and their families.

Ruth and Melvin joined the Andover Senior Center in 1997 and she enjoyed taking care of all the plants here as well as exercising with her good friend, Tess Sanborn. She and Melvin were married for 62 years and 10 months when he passed away on December 22, 2010.

Although her eyesight and hearing difficulties prevent her from walking over to the senior center now, she continues to maintain her membership and attends most of our fundraisers with her son Jim. 
