The Andover Senior Citizens Club, Inc., more commonly known as ASC or the Andover Senior Center, was founded in 1986 by four founding directors. Those four were Paul Scafe, Victor Cox, Harold Rickard and Ida Gooding. Originally the four directors also served as President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.

We have come a long way since then, but the basics are still the same and we are stronger than ever. We now have four officers and three trustees who volunteer their time and energy; we pay a director, part-time cook, janitor and accountant; AND we have the BEST volunteer members who help us accomplish the many tasks needed for the Center to run properly and as smoothly as possible.

We are governed by our by-laws, and we currently receive grants from Butler County and City of Andover, which covers less than half of our annual expenses. We receive additional income by many different means, fund-raising activities, membership dues and building rentals, just to name a few. In addition to these, we RELY on donations from members and the community to help supplement our budget. Expenses have recently risen, utility bills are higher than they have ever been and we also have maintenance requirements and unexpected repairs.




