The holiday season reminds us of good times and being together which also reminds us of our loss. The holidays force us to realize how much our lives have been changed by the loss particularly in the first year when we realize our holiday rituals and traditions are now being changed.

Remember, the anticipation of a holiday can be more difficult than the day itself. Here are some tips for coping:

Allow yourself to feel joy, sadness, anger-allow yourself to grieve.

Draw comfort from doing for others.

Surround yourself with people who love and support you.

The most important thing to remember is there is no right or wrong way to celebrate the holiday season after the death of a loved one. The best way to cope with the holiday is to plan ahead, get support from others and take it easy.

Shopping for Seniors
