ORDINANCE NO. 1849

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS REPEALING
AND REPLACING CHAPTER XVIII, ARTICLE 7, SECTIONS 18-707 AND
18-712 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS.**

WHEREAS, the City of Andover, Kansas (the "City") has previously adopted Chapter XVIII, Article 7 of the Code of the City of Andover, Kansas (the "Code") which contains provisions regarding towing service charges; and,

WHEREAS, the City finds it necessary and advisable to repeal and replace Chapter XVIII, Article 7, Sections 18-707 and 18-712 of the Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter XVIII, Article 7, Section 18-707 of the Code shall be repealed and replaced, as follows:

18-707. Fees and Charges.

All authorized tow service providers on the Police Department rotation tow list shall charge only those towing and storage fees as established by resolution of the Governing Body.

SECTION 2. Chapter XVIII, Article 7, Section 18-712 of the Code shall be repealed and replaced, as follows:

18-712. Maximum Tow and Storage Fees.

(a) The maximum towing, storage, and other fees for any vehicle towed or impounded pursuant to this Article shall be as established by resolution of the Governing Body.

(b) These fees include materials for clean-up of all accident debris, including but not limited to the use of oil dry or a similar product to clean up any fluid spills.

(c) An authorized tow service provider may charge a full day's storage fee for any portion of a day the vehicle is stored. Storage fees for Saturday, Sunday, or holiday storage are only permitted if tow company personnel are on site and available to release a vehicle from at least 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on those days.

(d) Every tow company, whether or not on the tow rotation list, is solely responsible for cleaning all accident debris, including but not limited to dirt, broken glass, metal or broken pieces, and the use of oil dry or a similar product to clean up any fluid spills, etc., from the

roadway unless otherwise directed by the City. All debris shall be removed and deposited in a trash receptacle at the tow company's place of business.


SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the Governing Body of the City, approval by the Mayor and publication one time in the City's official newspaper.
