ORDINANCE NO. 1853

AN ORDINANCE NO. REPEALING AND REPLACING SECTION 1-101 OF CHAPTER 1, ARTICLE 1 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ALLOWING THE MAYOR TO CANCEL NON-ESSENTIAL MEETINGS DURING TIMES OF EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 1, Article 1, Section 1-101 of the Code of the City of Andover, Kansas (the "Code") shall be repealed and replaced and shall read as follows:

1-101. Governing body meeting.

The regular meetings of the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas shall ordinarily be held semi-monthly on the second and last Tuesday of each month, in the Council Chambers in the City Hall of Andover, Kansas, commencing at 7:00 p.m. In addition to the foregoing regular meetings there shall also be a monthly workshop meeting ordinarily held on the last Monday before the last Tuesday of each month, which workshop meeting shall be held at such place or places in the City as from time to time selected by the Mayor and shall commence at 6:00 p.m. The Council shall be permitted to conduct any business which comes before it during any one of the three monthly meetings established herein with the primary purpose of the workshop meeting being to provide the Council with a regular time during which to discuss policy considerations and to devote its attention to issues requiring in-depth analysis. In addition to Special Meetings called pursuant to Kansas law, the Council may reschedule regular meetings when necessary to avoid holiday conflicts by approving a calendar of the scheduled regular meetings in December of the prior calendar year. *At any time during a State of Emergency described in Section 1-102.2, the Mayor may cancel any City Council, Planning Commission or other municipal government meeting which he or she deems non-essential with advance notice to the affected body, so long as the remainder of regular meetings shall fulfill the requirements of Kansas law.*

SECTION 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the governing body of the City, approval by the Mayor and publication once in the official newspaper of the City.
