LIEAP Program

LIEAP stands for Low Income Energy Assistance Program. This is a government program to help low income households pay their energy bills. Enrollment is Jan 3rd to March 31st.

An enrollment event is planned at the Augusta Community Caring Center, 1301 Helen, Augusta KS on March 7th from 10am to 2pm. Customer service representatives will be available to help people to apply for assistance. ***They must have at least 25 people to make this event happen***

If successful , this event will be held annually.

Identity Theft, How to Protect Yourself

In 1/3 of all ATM card frauds, cardholders wrote their PIN on their ATM card or on a slip of paper kept with their card.

Banking

Prevent identity theft:

Sign credit or bank cards when they arrive and carry them separately from your wallet.

Never have your SSN printed on your checks.

Do not let merchants handwrite your SSN on your checks.

Pick up new checks at the bank instead of having them mailed.

Store cancelled checks in a safe place.

If You Are A Victim:

Cancel the account.

Set up new accounts/passwords.

Stop payment on unauthorized checks.

Contact check verification companies that handle your checks.

ATMs

Shield your hand when using an ATM.

Memorize your PIN. Never carry it in your wallet or purse. Never write it on your ATM card or on the outside of a deposit slip or envelope.

Always take ATM receipts with you.

Monitor statements.

If your ATM card has been misused, report it immediately.

Follow-up all calls with a letter. Order a new card with a new account. Set up a new password or PIN.

Shopping for Seniors

It is designed to assist seniors who cannot shop for themselves but are capable of giving their grocery order over the telephone to volunteers who then pass the list to volunteer shoppers. Highlights of this program include:

There is no cost to participants (except for cost of their groceries).

Volunteers carry the groceries into the home.

Butler County Transportation

The Butler County Transit Program through the Butler County Department of Aging is a general public transportation program that offers a variety of routes throughout the county to help meet your travel needs. All general public transportation vehicles are handicapped accessible. Butler County Transit does not furnish wheelchairs.

Currently the general public transportation rides in the Andover area are available by reservation Monday through Friday from 8:30-3:00.
