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NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

TO: The Owners of Property in the City of Andover, Butler County, Kansas

You and each of you are hereby notified that the governing body of the City of Andover, Kansas, will hold a public hearing at City Hall, 1609 E. Central, Andover, Kansas, on Tuesday, May 9, 2023, at 7:00 P.M., for the purpose of receiving and hearing any and all complaints and objections to the proposed special assessments for improvements consisting of the construction of water, sanitary sewer, paving, and storm water drainage improvements in the City, as heretofore authorized by duly adopted Resolutions of the City.

The total final costs of the respective improvements and the properties specifically to be assessed for said costs are as follows:

1. The construction of Tuscany Phase 3 Water Improvements, as authorized by Resolution No. 20-08 adopted on March 31, 2020 and published April 11, 2020, which have been completed at a total final cost of \$62,700.00, twenty-five percent (25%) of which is payable by the City-at-Large and seventy-five percent (75%) of the entire cost of which will be specifically assessed on a per lot basis to each parcel served in the City of Andover, Butler County, Kansas, are described as follows:

Tuscany Addition, Third Phase, Final Planned Unit Development Plan
Block A, Lots 1 through 6, inclusive
Block B, Lots 1 through 6, inclusive

The construction of Tuscany Phase 3 Sewer Improvements, as authorized by Resolution No. 20-08 adopted on March 31, 2020 and published April 11, 2020, have been completed at a total final cost of \$126,500.00, twenty-five percent (25%) of which is payable by the City-at-Large and seventy-five percent (75%) of the entire cost of which will be specifically assessed on a per lot basis to each parcel served in the Tuscany Phase 3 Benefit District.

3. The construction of Tuscany Phase 3 Paving Improvements, as authorized by Resolution No. 20-08 adopted on March 31, 2020 and published April 11, 2020, have been completed at a total final cost of \$404,800.00, twenty-five percent (25%) of which is payable by the City-at-Large and seventy-five percent (75%) of the entire cost of which will be specifically assessed on a per lot basis to each parcel served in the Tuscany Phase 3 Benefit District.

4. The construction of Tuscany Phase 3 Storm Water Drain Improvements, as authorized by Resolution No. 20-08 adopted on March 31, 2020 and published April 11, 2020, which have been completed at a total final cost of \$244,200.00, twenty-five percent (25%) of which is payable by the City-at-Large and seventy-five percent (75%) of the entire cost of which will be specifically assessed on a fractional basis to each parcel served in the City of Andover, Butler County, Kansas, are described as follows:

The fractional shares provided for herein have been determined on the basis of shares being assessed to lots or parcels of substantially comparable size and value with consideration for their proximity to the improvements, as follows:

Lots 1 through 6, Block A, Lots 1-6, Block B and Lots 1 through 7, Block C, Tuscany Addition, Third Phase Final Planned Unit Development Plan shall each pay 1/38 of the cost payable by the Tuscany Phase 3 Storm Water Drain Improvements Benefit District; and Parcel A shall pay 19/38 of the total cost payable by the Tuscany Phase 3 Storm Water Drain Improvements Benefit District.

5. The construction of Cornerstone Eleventh Water Improvements, as authorized by Resolution No. 21-11 adopted on May 11, 2021 and published May 22, 2021, which have been completed at a total final cost of \$124,000.00, twenty-five percent (25%) of which is payable by the City-at-Large and seventy-five percent (75%) of the entire cost of which will be specifically assessed on equal share per lot basis to each parcel served in the City of Andover, Butler County, Kansas, are described as follows:

The Cornerstone Eleventh Addition
Block 1, Lots 2 through 9, inclusive
Block 2, Lots 2 through 31, inclusive

(the "Cornerstone Eleventh Benefit District").

6. The construction of Cornerstone Eleventh Sewer Improvements, as authorized by Resolution No. 21-11 adopted on May 11, 2021 and published May 22, 2021, have been completed at a total final cost of \$340,400.00, twenty-five percent (25%) of which is payable by the City-at-Large and seventy-five percent (75%) of the entire cost of which will be specifically assessed on equal share per lot basis to each parcel served in the Cornerstone Eleventh Benefit District.

7. The construction of Cornerstone Eleventh Paving Improvements, as authorized by Resolution No. 21-11 adopted on May 11, 2021 and published May 22, 2021, which have been completed at a total final cost of \$617,900.00, twenty-five percent (25%) of which is payable by the City-at-Large and seventy-five percent (75%) of the entire cost of which will be specifically assessed on a fractional basis to each parcel served in the City of Andover, Butler County, Kansas, are described as follows:

The Cornerstone Eleventh Addition
Block 1, Lots 2 through 9, inclusive
Block 2, Lots 2 through 31, inclusive

and

Lots 2 through 9, Block 1; and Lots 2 through 31, Block 2; shall pay generally 87.2% of the proportionate cost payable by the Cornerstone Eleventh Paving Improvements Benefit District on an equal share per lot basis; Unplatted School Tract shall pay 12.8% of the proportionate cost payable by the Cornerstone Eleventh Paving Improvements Benefit District, provided that the total assessment for the Unplatted School Tract will not exceed \$294,291.36 for the total phases of paving improvements benefitting said parcel with any overage being spread against the remaining Cornerstone Eleventh Paving Improvements Benefit District on a per lot basis.

8. The construction of Cornerstone Eleventh Drainage Improvements, as authorized by Resolution No. 21-11 adopted on May 11, 2021 and published May 22, 2021, as amended by Resolution No. 21-22 adopted August 10, 2021 and published August 21, 2021, have been completed at a total final cost of \$318,700.00, zero percent (0.00%) of which is payable by the City-at-Large and one hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of which will be specifically assessed on a fractional basis to each parcel served in the Cornerstone Eleventh Benefit District.

The fractional shares provided for herein have been determined on the basis of shares being assessed to lots or parcels of substantially comparable size and value with consideration for their proximity to the Project, as follows:

Lots 2 through 9, Block 1 and Lots 2 through 3, Block 2 shall each pay 232/10000 of the total cost payable by the Cornerstone Eleventh Benefit District on an equal share per lot basis; Lots 4 through 14, Block 2 shall each pay 233/10000 of the total cost payable by the Cornerstone Eleventh Benefit District on an equal share per lot basis; Lots 15 through 31, Block 2 shall each pay 301/10000 of the total cost payable by the Cornerstone Eleventh Benefit District on an equal share per lot basis.

9. The construction of Hodges Sixth Subdivision Water Improvements, as authorized by Resolution No. 21-28 adopted on October 12, 2021 and published October 23, 2021, which have been completed at a total final cost of \$132,900.00, zero percent (0.00%) of which is payable by the City-at-Large and one Hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of which will be specifically assessed on a per lot basis to each parcel served in the City of Andover, Butler County, Kansas, are described as follows:

Hodges Sixth Subdivision

Block A, Lots 1 through 13, inclusive

Block B, Lots 1 through 4, inclusive

(collectively, the “Hodges Sixth Subdivision Benefit District”).

10. The construction of Hodges Sixth Subdivision Sewer Improvements, as authorized by Resolution No. 21-28 adopted on October 12, 2021 and published October 23, 2021, have been completed at a total final cost of \$355,700.00, zero percent (0.00%) of which is payable by the City-at-Large and one hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of which will be specifically assessed on a per lot basis to each parcel served in the Hodges Sixth Subdivision Benefit District.

11. The construction of Hodges Sixth Subdivision Paving Improvements, as authorized by Resolution No. 21-28 adopted on October 12, 2021 and published October 23, 2021, have been completed at a total final cost of \$347,400.00, zero percent (0.00%) of which is payable by the City-at-Large and one hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost

of which will be specifically assessed on a per lot basis to each parcel served in the Hodges Sixth Subdivision Benefit District.

12. The construction of Hodges Sixth Subdivision Storm Water Improvements, as authorized by Resolution No. 21-28 adopted on October 12, 2021 and published October 23, 2021, have been completed at a total final cost of \$591,600.00, zero percent (0.00%) of which is payable by the City-at-Large and one hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of which will be specifically assessed on a per lot basis to each parcel served in the Hodges Sixth Subdivision Benefit District.

13. The construction of Hodges Seventh Subdivision Water Improvements, as authorized by Resolution No. 21-30 adopted on November 9, 2021 and published November 20, 2021, which have been completed at a total final cost of \$48,300.00, zero percent (0.00%) of which is payable by the City-at-Large and one hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of which will be specifically assessed on a per lot basis to each parcel served in the City of Andover, Butler County, Kansas, are described as follows:

Hodges Seventh Subdivision:
Block A, Lot 1

(collectively, the “Hodges Seventh Subdivision Benefit District”).

14. The construction of Hodges Seventh Subdivision Sewer Improvements, as authorized by Resolution No. 21-30 adopted on November 9, 2021 and published November 20, 2021, have been completed at a total final cost of \$78,000.00, zero percent (0.00%) of which is payable by the City-at-Large and one hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of which will be specifically assessed on a per lot basis to each parcel served in the Hodges Seventh Subdivision Benefit District.

15. The construction of Hodges Seventh Subdivision Storm Water Improvements, as authorized by Resolution No. 21-30 adopted on November 9, 2021 and published November 20, 2021, have been completed at a total final cost of \$56,700.00, zero percent (0.00%) of which is payable by the City-at-Large and one hundred percent (100%) of the entire cost of which will be specifically assessed on a per lot basis to each parcel served in the Hodges Seventh Subdivision Benefit District.


The Certification of Total Final Costs and Assessment Roll for said improvements are on file in the Office of the City Clerk and may be examined by any interested party. Anyone desiring to make any complaint or objection to the assessments set forth in the Assessment Roll, may appear and will be heard at the public hearing. After hearing and considering any and all written or oral complaints or objections to the various assessments, the respective amounts of each and all of the assessments shall be finally determined by the governing body and shall be levied by an ordinance of the City and property owners will have until noon on Tuesday, June 20, 2023 during which special assessments may be paid in cash before the assessments are placed on the tax rolls for collection in Twenty annual installments of principal and interest.

The governing body has determined that the first tax levy for the unpaid special assessments shall be certified to the Butler County Clerk for inclusion on the November 2023 tax statements. Pursuant to K.S.A. 12-6a11, you have 30 days from the publication of the assessment ordinance to bring a suit to set aside said assessments or otherwise question the validity of the proceedings.
