If you are homebound, and live in or near the city of Andover, we can deliver lunch to you.

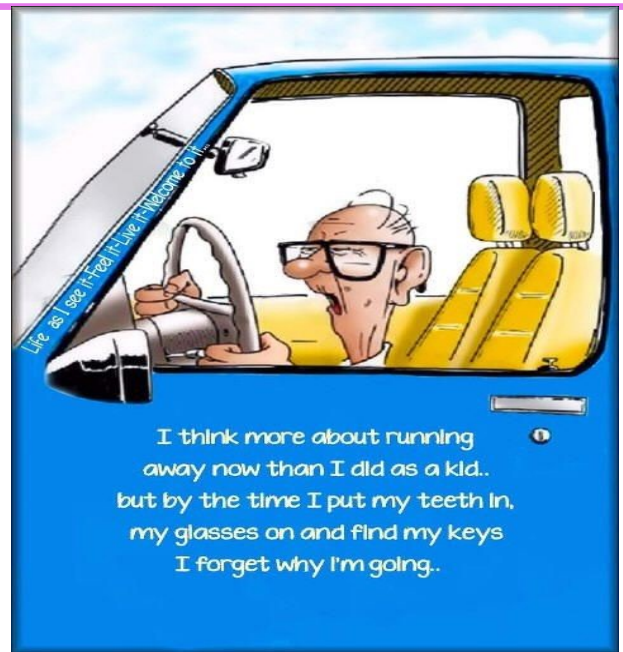
