Central, Andover, Kansas 67002. Said Bonds are proposed to be issued by the City in the amount not to exceed \$1,800,000 to finance the costs of purchasing, acquiring, constructing, furnishing and equipping an industrial facility consisting of an expansion of an existing facility located at 215 E. 13th Street in Andover, Kansas (the "Project").

Said Bonds, which will make all or portion of the Project eligible for an accompanying ad valorem property tax exemption, are proposed to be issued under the authority of K.S.A. 12-1740 to 12-1749d, inclusive, as amended. The proposed Project would be owned or leased by the City and leased to Everidge, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, or its affiliates (the "Tenant"). A copy of this notice relating to the proposed financing is on file in the office of the City Clerk and is available for public inspection during normal business hours.

In the event said Bonds are not ultimately issued for any reason, the City, shall not be deemed to have assumed or incurred any liability or obligation to the Tenant, its affiliates, or any other party by virtue of any proceedings or actions taken in connection therewith.

All persons having an interest in this matter will be given an opportunity to be heard at the time and place specified.

The governing body of the City will not take action authorizing the issuance of such Bonds or approving the accompanying tax abatement until the passage of seven (7) days from the date this Notice is published in the official newspaper of the City and until said public hearing is concluded.
