ORDINANCE NO. 1879

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1847 OF THE CITY OF  
ANDOVER, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Andover, Kansas (the “City”) has heretofore by Resolution No. 22-45, adopted October 25, 2022 and published in the City’s official newspaper as required by law on November 5, 2022, as amended by Resolution No. 23-20 adopted this July 25, 2023 and to be published August 5, 2023 (collectively, the “Authorizing Resolution”), found and determined it to be advisable and authorized the making of Summerlin Water Improvements, Summerlin Sewer Improvements, Summerlin Paving Improvements, and Summerlin Storm Water Drainage Improvements (collectively, the “Improvements”) in the City, as provided by K.S.A. 12-6a01 *et seq.*, as amended and supplemented, at a total estimated cost of \$1,842,000, a portion of which costs will be levied and assessed against properties benefiting from the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City finds and determines it advisable to amend Ordinance No. 1847 of the City adopted October 25, 2022 and published in the City’s official newspaper as required by law on November 5, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY  
OF ANDOVER, KANSAS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment to Recitals of Ordinance No. 1847. The first and second recitals of Ordinance No. 1339 are hereby amended by replacing them with the following:

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Andover, Kansas (the “City”) has heretofore, by Resolution No. 22-45 (the “Authorizing Resolution”) duly adopted this October 25, 2022 and published in the City’s official newspaper as required by law on November 5, 2022, as amended by Resolution No. 23-24 duly adopted this July 25, 2023, and to be published in the City’s official newspaper as required by law on August 5, 2023 (collectively, the “Authorizing Resolution”), found and determined it to be advisable and authorized the making of certain Summerlin Water Improvements, Summerlin Sewer Improvements, Summerlin Paving Improvements and Summerlin Storm Water Drainage Improvements (collectively, the “Improvements”) in the City, as provided by K.S.A. 12-6a01 *et seq.*, as amended and supplemented, at a total estimated cost of \$1,842,000 (said cost may be increased to include temporary interest or finance costs incurred during the course of design and construction of the project, and also may be increased at the rate of 1% per month from and after October 1, 2022), which costs will be levied and assessed against properties benefiting from the Improvements; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City, upon an examination thereof, has considered and found and determined certain subject petitions filed on October

17, 2022 and June 14, 2023 (collectively, the “Petitions”) to be sufficient, having been signed by the owners of record, whether resident or not, of all of the property liable for assessment for the costs of the Improvements; and

Section 2.     Amending Ordinance. This ordinance supplements and amends Ordinance No. 1847 only to the extent necessary to reflect the receipt of the revised petition reflecting a change in the estimated costs. Except to the extent specifically amended hereby, Ordinance No. 1847 shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 3.     Effective Date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its adoption by the governing body of City of Andover, Kansas and its publication in the official newspaper of the City.
