There is no cost to participants (except for cost of their groceries).

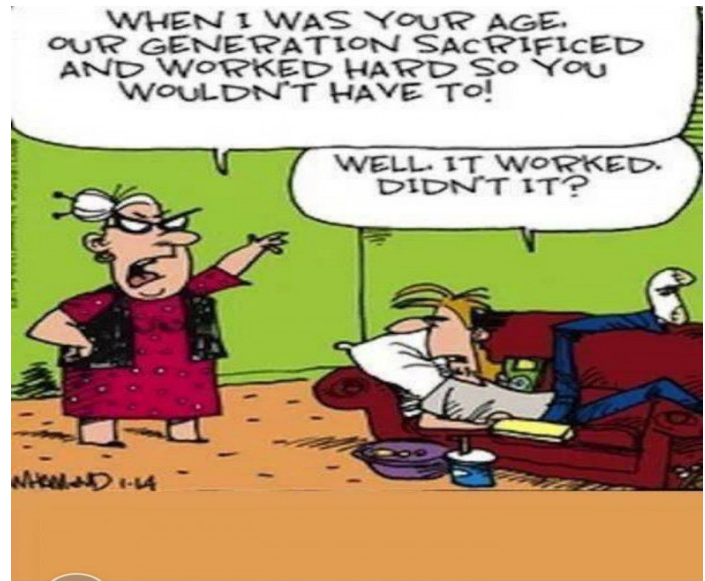
Volunteers carry the groceries into the home.

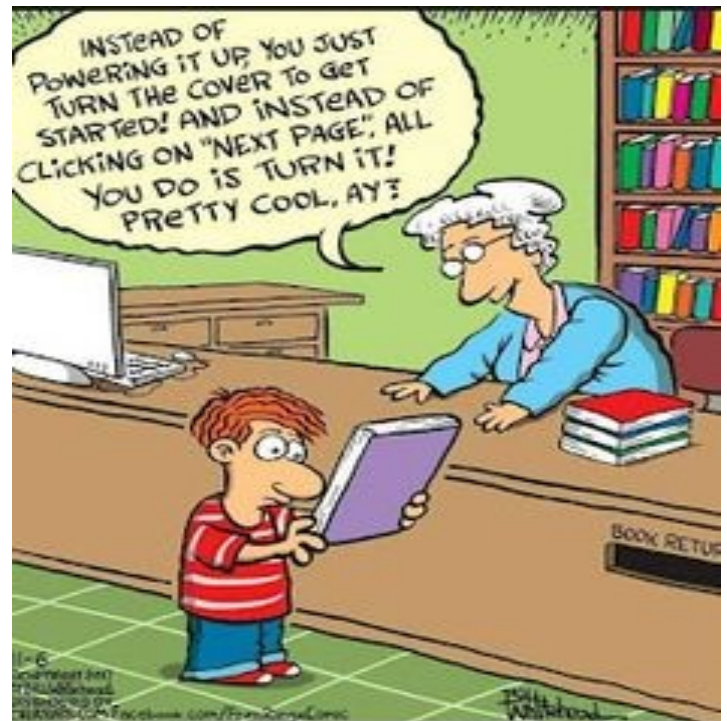
