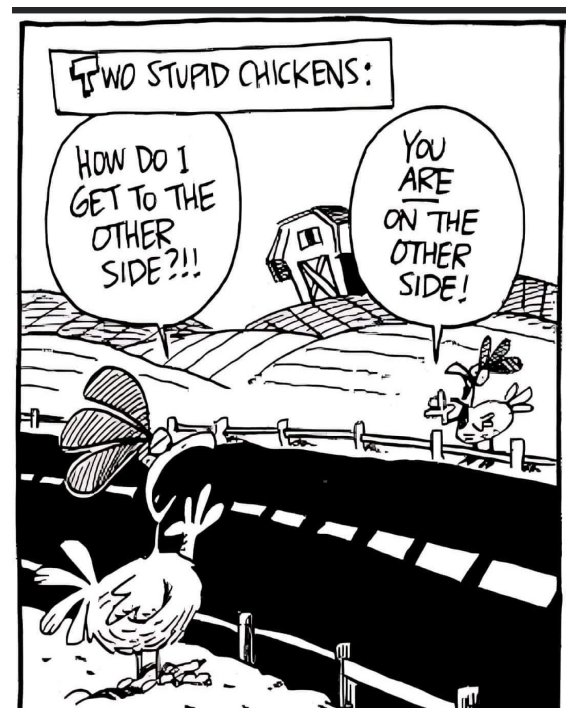

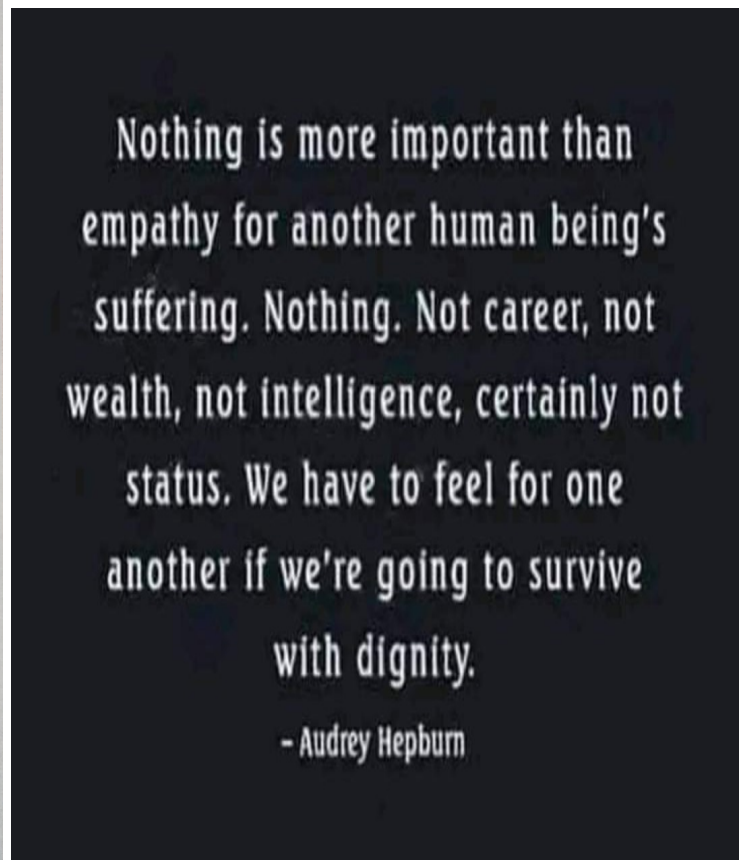


Free food is being distributed at The Augusta Community Caring Center Commodities Distribution Center for low-income individuals who live in Butler County.

The Andover Community Food Bank has been a part of Andover for over 30 years. It is supported by citizens of Andover, through school and scout drives and donations from civic organizations and many individuals. The qualification to receive food is independent of income-if there is need, the food bank can assist with groceries. *Andover Community Food Bank is located inside the Andover United Methodist Church at 1429 N. Andover Rd. The hours are Tuesday, 10 AM to 1 PM and Wednesday, 3 PM to 6 PM..* Clients may receive groceries once a month, up to 6 times a year.

The Andover Food Bank is always in need of non-perishable food items, such as peanut butter , canned items such as canned veggies, fruit, beans, stews, and tuna. All donations are appreciated.

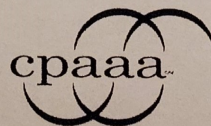

2. Stop pre-approved credit cards at www.OptOutPrescreen.com or 1-888-OPT-OUT
3. Register for a secure Social Security account at www.ssa.gov.MyAccount
4. Register for a secure Medicare account at www.medicare.gov

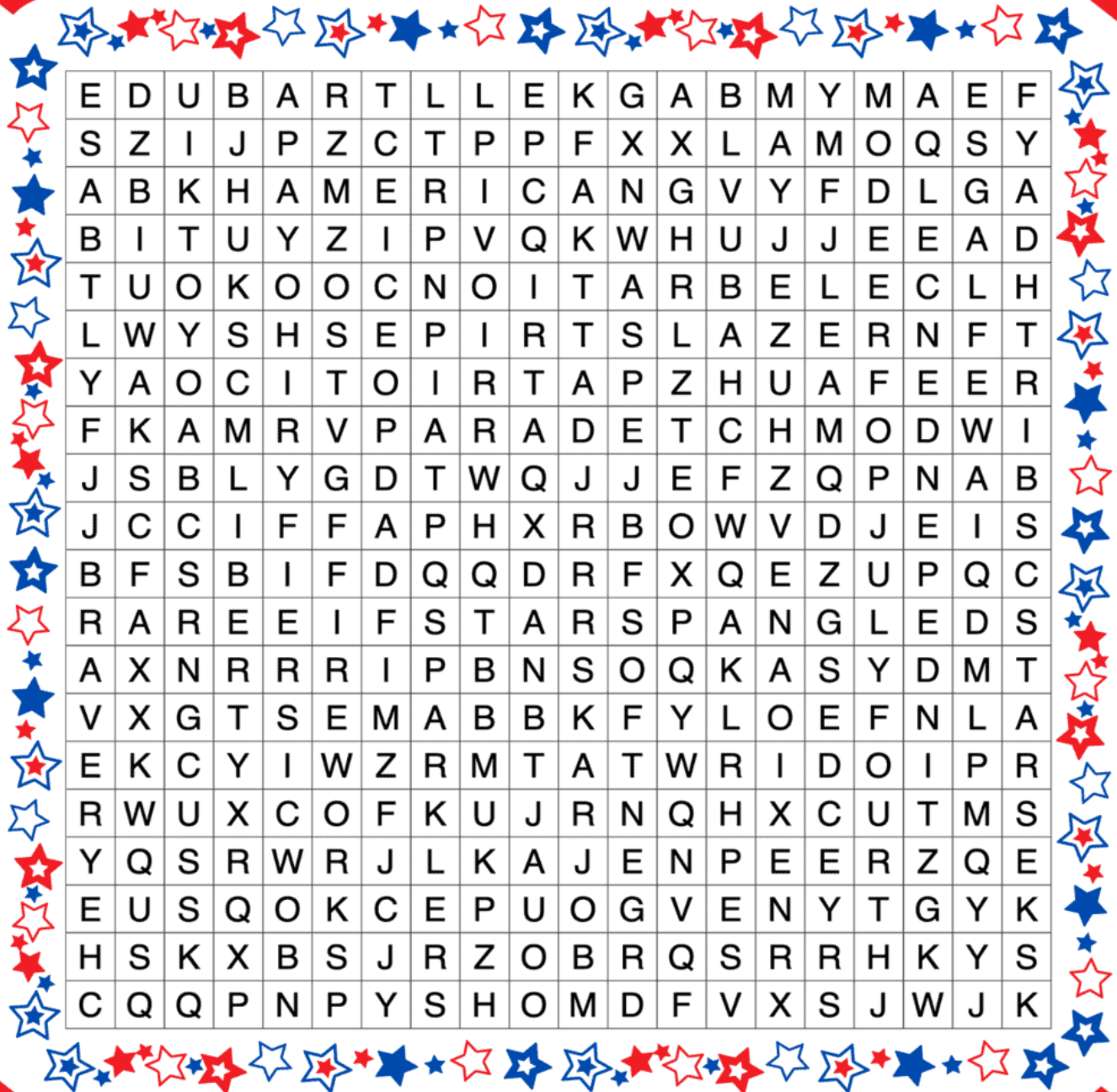
