{Low Income Energy Assistance Program}

Wednesday January 8th @ 12noon

If you would like to sign up for LIEP and need help with the forms please come with the following items:

1. Copy of utility bills {electric/gas}
2. Proof of income {pay stubs, Social security, etc..}
3. Copy of rental lease [if applicant is renting]

To apply on line visit dcf.ks.gov and click on "apply for services"

Application period runs from Nov 18th, 2024, to March 31st 2025.

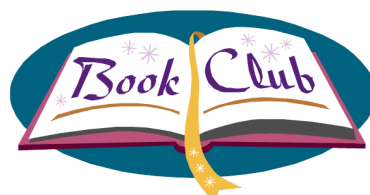
