

POSTED ON THE 10th DAY OF June 1957.

AN ORDINANCE ORGANIZING THE CITY COUNCIL OF ANDOVER, KANSAS,
AND ESTABLISHING REGULAR MEETING AND MEETING PLACE OF SAID
COUNCIL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER,
KANSAS

SECTION 1: The Governing Body of said City shall have
its regular meeting on the second Saturday of each month at
7:30 o'clock, p.m. at the Andover Fire Station Annex; Provided,
that when any day fixed for a regular meeting shall fall
on any legal holiday, or a day observed as a holiday in the
city, the regular meeting shall convene on the succeeding
Saturday that is not observed as a legal holiday or as ordered
by the Council at any previous meeting, regular or special.

SECTION 2: Any special meeting may be called by the Mayor
on the written request of not less than three (3) members of
the Council addressed to the Mayor, specifying the object and
purpose of the meeting, which request must be read at the
meeting and entered at length on the Journal.

SECTION 3: A majority of the Councilmen-elect shall
constitute a Quorum to do business, but any less number may
adjourn from day to day and compel the attendance of absent
members of the Council by attachment issued in the name of
the city and directed to the City Marshall commanding him to
arrest such absentee members and bring them forthwith before
the Council and the Council may fine such absentees in any
amount not exceeding ten dollars (\$10.00) unless a reason-
able excuse be offered.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become of full force
and effect from and after its posting as required by law.

Passed and adopted the 20th day of April, 1957 by the
Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas.
