

Ordinance No. 4

POSED ON THE 10<sup>th</sup> DAY OF June 1957

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO PRISONERS AND THE MAINTENANCE OF PRISONERS AND JAIL FACILITIES WITHIN THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS AND AUTHORIZING THE MARSHAL OF SAID CITY TO CONFINCE CITY PRISONERS IN THE COUNTY JAIL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

SECTION 1: That the Marshal of the City of Andover, Kansas shall use such places as are reasonably available for jail facilities within the City Andover, Kansas, for jail facilities and the maintenance of City prisoners.

SECTION 2: That in addition to the provisions made for jail facilities in Section 1 hereinabove, the Marshal of the City of Andover, Kansas is authorized and empowered to confine persons charged with the violation of an ordinance of the City of Andover, Kansas in the county Jail of Butler County, Kansas in the City of El Dorado, pursuant to Section 19-1920, General Statutes of Kansas 1951, as amended.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall become of full force and effect from and after its posting as required by law.

Passed and adopted the 20th day of April, 1957 by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas.
