ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PLUMBING CODE AND
REGULATIONS FOR THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS
AND IMPOSING A LICENSE FEE AND PROVIDING FOR
PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
ANDOVER, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That anyone engaging in or desiring to engage in the business of plumbing in the City of Andover, Kansas, shall before obtaining a permit, procure a License from the City Clerk of the City of Andover, Kansas, which License shall expire on the first day of May after the year in which issued. No License shall be transferred from one person to another.

SECTION 2. Before a plumbing License is issued, the applicant shall file with the City Clerk a Surety Bond in the amount of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.) which shall require the approval of the City Council. The condition of said Bond to be that the principal therein will comply with all ordinances of the City relating to and regulating plumbing.

SECTION 3. Bond shall also hold and save the City of Andover, Kansas harmless from any and all damages to persons or property resulting from or growing out of any opening or excavation of any sort made, or from any operation made within the City of Andover, Kansas.

SECTION 4. Fee for plumbing license shall be five dollars (\$5.00).

SECTION 5. Any person or persons, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.) or to be imprisoned not to exceed three (3) months, or be both so fined and imprisoned. Each day that a violation is continued shall be considered a separate and distinct violation and may be prosecuted as such.
