

ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULAR CITY ELECTION

Be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas.

SECTION 1: That the regular city election of the City, of Andover, Kansas, shall be held on Tuesday, the 7th day of April 1959, from the hours of 8:00a.m. to 6:00 p.m. in the Andover Fire Station for the purpose of electing a Mayor, a police Judge, and five Councilmen.

SECTION 2: That Mrs. Lela Long, Mrs. Roy Allison, and Mrs. Grant Winslow Not candidates fir office, are here by designated by the Mayor with the approval of the Council, to act as Judges of said election and Mrs. H.L. Rowland and Mrs. Nellie Belford citizens not, not Councilmen, are hereby designated by the Council to act as clerks of said election.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force ~~from~~ ^{AFTER} its being published in the Western Butler County Times, Towanda Kansas, official publisher for the City of Andover, Kansas.
