ORDINANCE NO. 26-102

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY:

Blocks 1, 2, 5, 7 and 8, Block 6, except Lots 1 to 6, inclusive of Town Company Addition to the City of Andover, Kansas, including all streets and alleys adjacent to such lots and blocks and all lying north of the Kansas Turnpike between El Dorado Street and the alley west of Church Street.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER:

SECTION 1: That the following described platted lands adjoining or touching the limits of the City of Andover, Kansas, all of which land is located in the County of Butler, State of Kansas, is hereby added to, taken into and made a part of the City of Andover, Kansas:

Blocks 1, 2, 5, 7 and 8, Block 6, except Lots 1 to 6, inclusive of Town Company Addition to the City of Andover, Kansas, including all streets and alleys adjacent to such lots and blocks and all lying north of the Kansas Turnpike between El Dorado Street and the alley west of Church Street.

SECTION 2: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city paper.

Passed by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds of the members-elect voting in favor thereof, the 20th day of January, 1965.

ORDINANCE NO. 26-101

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ANNEXATION TO THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, CERTAIN PROPERTIES OWNED BY JAMES W. FLENER AND VIVIAN FLENER, ON THEIR PETITION SUBMITTED TO THE CITY COUNCIL ON THE 9<sup>th</sup> DAY OF NOVEMBER, 1964.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS.

SECTION 1. THAT THE PROPERTY DESCRIBED HERE-ON BE ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS AS REQUESTED ON A PETITION SIGNED BY SAID PARTIES.

SECTION 2. A tract of land beginning at a point 60 feet north of the north west corner of block three (3) of the Heorman Second Addition in section eight (8) of T 275-R3 E Butler, County, Kansas; thence north 152.15 feet to the south right of way line of the S.L. and S.F. R. R.; thence southeasterly along said right of way to a point 6.82 feet north and 370 feet east of said point of beginning; thence south 6.82 feet; thence west 370 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its posting as perscribed by law.
