

ORDINANCE, NO. 27

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR, AND CONTROLLING THE USE OF FIREARMS OF ANY SORT, WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS. G.S. 1949, 15-423, 15-436, 21-2411.

Be it ordained by the governing body of the city of Andover, Kansas.

SECTION 1: DISCHARGING OF FIREARMS:

It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to discharge any gun, revolver, pistol, or other deadly firearm of any sort, within the city limits of Andover, except, in the act of self defense, or by officers of the law in the discharge of their duties. Upon conviction thereof, violations of this section shall be fined, not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00).

SECTION 2: DANGEROUS WEAPONS.

Any person or persons who shall make any demonstration in a hostile manner with any dangerous or deadly weapon against the person or property of another, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00), or imprisoned and confined in the county jail, of Butler County, Kansas, not exceeding ninety (90) days, or both so fined and imprisoned, at the discretion of the court. The provisions of this section shall not apply to officers of the law and their deputies in the performance of their duties.

SECTION 3: DISCHARGE OF B.B. AND/OR PELLET GUN WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS.

It shall be unlawful for any person, child or adult, to discharge any B.B. gun or pellet gun within the city of Andover. Any parent or other person having the legal custody and control of any minor who permits said child to own or have access to any B.B. gun and/or pellet gun, whose said child unlawfully discharges said gun within the city of Andover, shall be legally responsible for the act of said child. Said parent or other person having the legal custody thereof, shall be fined not less than five dollars (\$5.00), nor more than fifty dollars (\$50.00). Any B.B. or pellet gun fired within the city limits of Andover, is declared to be a nuisance and shall be ordered confiscated by the judge.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall become of full force and effect from and after it is posted as required by law G.S. 1949, 15-107.
