ORDINANCE NO. 35

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULAR CITY ELECTION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF
ANDOVER, KANSAS.

SECTION 1: That the regular city election of the city of Andover, Kansas, shall be held on Tuesday the 2nd day of April, 1963, from the hours of 8:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. in the city hall, for the purpose of electing a MAYOR, a POLICE JUDGE, and FIVE COUNCILMEN.

SECTION 2: That Mrs. Nellie Belford, Mrs. Orpha Winslow, and Mrs. Naomi Allison, citizens, not candidates for office, are hereby designated by the Mayor with the approval of the Council, to act as judges of said election; and Mrs. Carol Gardner, and Mrs. Harold Long, citizens, not Councilmen, are hereby designated by the Council to act as clerks of said election.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after it is posted in ten (10) public places as prescribed in the 1949 statutes 15-107.
