ORDINANCE NO. 56

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING LAND ANNEXING ORDINANCE NUMBERED 41 OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, BY THE REMOVAL OF THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 18, Township 27 South, Range 3 East of the 6th P.M., in Butler County, Kansas, thence running West to the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section, thence running North to the center line of East Tenth Street, thence running East to the East Section line of said Section 18, thence running South to the point of beginning.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER:

SECTION 1: That Ordinance Numbered 41 annexed to the City of Andover, Kansas, the following described property:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 18, Township 27 South, Range 3 East of the 6th P.M., in Butler County, Kansas, and running thence west to the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 18; thence north to the south line of Hodges Second Sub-division to Butler County, Kansas; thence east to the east line of said Section 18; thence south to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2: That said ordinance is hereby amended by removing therefrom and from the city limits of Andover, Kansas, the following described property:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section 18, Township 27 South, Range 3 East of the 6th P.M., in Butler County, Kansas, thence running West to the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of said Section, thence running North to the center line of East Tenth Street, thence running East to the East Section line of said Section 18, thence running South to the point of beginning.

SECTION 3: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city paper.

Passed by the Governing Body, not less than two-thirds of the members-elect voting in favor thereof, this 8th day of March, 1966.
