ORDINANCE NO. 60  
City of Andover, Kansas  
AN ORDINANCE ENLARGING  
THE BOUNDARIES OF THE  
CITY OF ANDOVER, KAN-  
SAS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the governing body of the City of Andover, Kansas:

SECTION 1. That D. H. Lockhart and Theda L. Lockhart, Ira L. Leatherman and Grace A. Leatherman, being all the owners of the real property hereinabove described, have consented to addition of such real property to the City of Andover, Kansas:

Beginning at the southwest corner of the SW/4, Section 8, T 27 S, R 3 E of the 6th P. M., Butler County, Kansas; thence east 223.2 feet; thence north 460.12 feet to the south line of the Kansas Turnpike Authority; thence southwesterly 262.29 feet along Kansas Turnpike Authority to the intersection of the west line of SW/4 of said section; thence south 321.45 feet to beginning; Beginning 422 feet east of the southeast corner of Section 7, T 27 S, R 3 E, Butler County, Kansas, and running thence east 215 feet; thence north to the south right of way of the Kansas Turnpike Authority; thence southwesterly along said south right of way line to a point north of the point of beginning; thence south to the point of beginning; southeasterly 600 feet west of the of Section 7, T 27 S, R 3 E of the 6th P. M., Butler County, Kansas, and running thence north 370 feet; thence west 180 feet; thence south 40 feet; thence west 100 feet; thence south 110 feet; thence southwest 56.4 feet; thence southeasterly 56.7 feet; thence south 140 feet; thence east 280 feet to the place of beginning, containing 2.32 acres more or less.

SECTION 2. That the boundaries of Andover, Kansas, are enlarged to include the above described real property in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 15-11a02.
