ORDINANCE NO. 61

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 58 OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, REPEALING SAID ORIGINAL SECTION AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A TEMPORARY IMPROVEMENT NOTE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 58 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: "SECTION 1. That in order to furnish an outlet for sewage in the City of Andover, Kansas, it is deemed and declared and declared necessary to construct and there is hereby ordered constructed an outfall sewer beginning 120 feet north and 950 feet west of the east quarter corner of Section 7, T 27 S, R 3 E of the 6th P. M. Butler County, Kansas and running thence north 890 feet; thence east to Andover Road; thence south 155 feet; thence east to the east line of the west one-half of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 8, T 27 S R 3 E; thence south to the north right of way line of the St. Louis-San Francisco Railroad; thence southeast 450 feet more or less to the City of Andover sewage purification plant".

SECTION 2. That original Section 1 of Ordinance No. 58 be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. That the Total cost of said project has been ascertained to be the sum of \$32,102.44 and temporary improvement notes in the amount of \$26,000.00 have been issued on this project.

SECTION 4. That to provide funds temporarily to finance the cost of a portion of the improvements until the sale of bonds to be issued therefor, the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Andover, Kansas, be and they are hereby authorized and directed to issue Temporary improvement Note No. 3, Series of 1966, in denomination of \$6,000.00. dated August 15, 1966, to mature on or before August 15, 1968, and to bear interest at the rate of four and one-half per cent (4 $\frac{1}{2}$ %) per annum from date of issue until paid; which said note shall be redeemed and taken up when funds are available for that purpose from the proceeds of general obligation bonds to be hereafter sold to pay for said improvement.

SECTION 5. That this ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication once in the official city paper.
