ORDINANCE NO. 66

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE RECONSTRUCTION,  
ENLARGEMENT AND EXTENSION OF THE SEWAGE DISPOSAL  
PLANT OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, AND  
AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF TEMPORARY IMPROVE-  
MENT NOTES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF  
ANDOVER, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That in order to provide sewage disposal services for the City of Andover, Kansas, County Sewer Districts and the school district, it is deemed and declared necessary to reconstruct, enlarge and extend the sewage disposal plant.

SECTION 2. That the total cost of said improvements is estimated to be \$57,000.00, of which \$24,800.00 will be paid by Butler County Sewer Districts and \$32,200.00 shall be provided by the issuance of general obligation bonds of the city as provided by law.

SECTION 3. That to provide funds temporarily to finance the cost of a portion of the improvements until the sale of bonds to be issued therefor, the Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Andover, Kansas, be and they are hereby authorized and directed to issue Temporary Notes Nos. 4 and 5, Series of 1966, in denominations of \$15,200.00 and \$17,000.00, respectively, dated December 1, 1966, to mature on or before December 1, 1968, and to bear interest at the rate of four and one-half per cent (4-1/2%) per annum from date of issue until paid; which said notes shall be redeemed and taken up when funds are available for that purpose from the proceeds of general obligation bonds to be hereafter sold to pay for said improvement.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication once in the official city paper.
