ORDINANCE NO. 70

An Ordinance Providing for the Regular City Election of Andover, Kansas

Be it Ordained by the governing body of the City of Andover, Kansas:

Section 1. That the regular city election of the City of Andover, Kansas, shall be held on Tuesday the 4th day of April, 1967, from the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. in the City Hall, for the purpose of electing a mayor and three councilmen.

Section 2. That Mrs. Vivian Flenner, Mrs. Lola Long, and Mrs. Gerry Wallace citizens not candidates for office, are hereby designated by the mayor, with the approval of the council, to act as judges of said election: and Mrs. Orpha Winslow and Mrs. Bob Journagan not councilmen, are hereby designated by the council to act as clerks of said election.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official newspaper of the city.
