

ORDINANCE NO. 88

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS IN SECTIONS 18 and 19, TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST, AS ARE MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1 HEREOF, TO THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, AND ENLARGING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. That the following lands be annexed to the City of Andover, Kansas:

- (a) Reserve A, Block 4 and Lots 6, 7, 8 and 9, Block 3, Koob Tracts, a subdivision of Butler County, Kansas together with the abutting and included streets and roads.
- (b) A tract beginning 435.40 feet west and 408 feet north of the southeast corner of Section 18, T 27 S, R 3 E, Butler County, Kansas and running thence south 408 feet to the south section line; thence east 104 feet; thence north 408 feet; thence west 104 feet to the place of beginning.
- (c) A tract beginning 555.29 feet west of the southeast corner of Section 18, T 27 S, R 3 E, Butler County, Kansas and running thence north 408 feet; thence west 106 feet; thence south 408 feet; thence east 106 feet to the place of beginning.
- (d) A tract beginning at the east section line of Section 18, T 27 S, R 3 E, Butler County, Kansas 30 feet east of the northeast corner of Lot 11, Malcom Tracts and running thence west 330 feet; thence north 104 feet; thence east 330 feet; thence south 104 feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION 2. That the boundaries of the City of Andover, Kansas, are enlarged to include the above described real property in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 15-11a02 and K.S.A. 1967 Supp. 12-519 et seq.

SECTION 3. That the invalidity of the annexation of any tract or land in Section 1 hereof shall not affect the validity of the annexation of the remaining tracts or lands in said section.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official paper.
