ORDINANCE NO. 108

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS IN SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 3 EAST, AS ARE MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1 HEREOF, TO THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, AND ENLARGING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the following described lands be annexed and added to the corporate limits of the city of Andover, Kansas.

Beginning 1320.76 feet East and 50 feet North of the Southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter, Section 8, Township 27 South, Range 3 East of the 6th P.M., Butler County, Kansas, and running thence East 1320.76 feet to the East line of said Southwest Quarter; thence North along said East Line a distance of 784.52 feet to the Southwesterly right-of-way line of the St. Louis-San Francisco Railroad; thence Northwesterly along said right-of-way line a distance of 1016.09 feet, plus or minus, to a point 255 feet Southeasterly at right angles to the center line survey of the Kansas Turnpike at Station 5402 plus 72.53; thence Southwesterly and parallel to said center line a distance of 442.90 feet, more or less, to a point 255 feet Southeasterly at right angles to said center line at Station 5398 plus 29.63; thence South to the point of beginning, containing 31.1 acres, more or less.

Section 2. The above described real property is annexed pursuant to the authorization of Chapter 98 session laws of Kansas, 1967, and it is hereby determined that such land adjoins the said city and is owned by or held in trust by said city.

Section 3. That the invalidity of the annexation of any tract or land in Section 1 hereof shall not affect the validity of the annexation of the remaining tracts or lands in said section.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official paper.

This ordinance passed and adopted this 12 day of July, 1969, by the Governing Body of the city of Andover, Kansas.
