ORDINANCE NO. 109

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LANDS IN SECTION 8, TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE # 3 EAST, AS ARE MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1 HEREOF, TO THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, AND ENLARGING THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the following described lands be annexed and added to the corporate limits of the city of Andover, Kansas.

Beginning 1320.76 feet East and 50 feet North of the Southwest corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 8, Township 27 South, Range 3 East of the 6th P.M., Butler County, Kansas, and running thence North to a point 295 feet Southeasterly at right angles to the center line survey of the Kansas Turnpike at Station 5398 plus 08.47; thence Southwesterly and parallel to said center line a distance of 608.47 feet; thence Northwesterly and normal to the Northeasterly tangent of a curve whose point of intersection is at Station 5390 plus 4130 of said center line survey for a distance of 40.0 feet to a point 255 feet Southeasterly at right angles to said tangent; thence Southwesterly and parallel to said tangent a distance of 150.74 feet to a point and on a line projected through said point of intersection and the radius point of said curve; thence Northwesterly along said projected line a distance of 10.43 feet to a point; thence deflecting left 146 degrees, 31 minutes and 45 seconds a distance of 646.18 feet; thence East parallel to and 50 distant from the South line of said Southwest Quarter a distance of 682.56 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning, containing 12.3 acres, more or less.

Section 2. The above described real property is annexed pursuant to the authorization of Chapter 98 session laws of Kansas, 1967, and it is hereby determined by said governing body that said real property is so situated that two-thirds (2/3) of a boundary line of said real property adjoins the city of Andover, Kansas, and it is further determined that said tract of real property is not in excess of twenty (20) acres.

Section 3. That the invalidity of the annexation of any tract or land in Section 1 hereof shall not affect the validity of the annexation of the remaining tracts or lands in said section.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official paper.

This ordinance passed and adopted this 12 day of July, 1969 by the Governing Body of the city of Andover, Kansas.
