ORDINANCE NO. 110

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE OFFENSE OF CARELESS DRIVING AND MAKING IT A CRIME TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE IN A CARELESS MANNER AND PROVIDING FOR FINES AND IMPRISONMENT, OR BOTH, FOR VIOLATION THERE OF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to drive or operate a motor vehicle upon a highway or street in said city in a careless or heedless or an inattentive manner or without due caution or circumspection or in any manner not constituting reckless driving but so as to endanger any person or property.

Section 2. That any person operating a motor vehicle in any of the manners described in Section 1 hereof in the corporate limits of the city of Andover shall be deemed guilty of the crime or offense of careless driving.

Section 3. Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in a sum not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00, or be imprisoned not to exceed 30 days, or be both so fined and imprisoned.

The above Ordinance duly adopted at a regular meeting of the Governing Body on the 9 day of Aug, 1969.
