ORDINANCE NO. 120

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE OFFENSE OF LOITERING, MAKING THE SAME UNLAWFUL AND PROVIDING FOR FINE AND PENALTIES FOR CONVICTION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to loaf, obstruct or loiter in or in front of the entrance to or in any stairway or hall leading to any business, office rooms or other public building or place in the City of Andover, Kansas. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in any amount not less than Five Dollars (\$5) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100), or be imprisoned not to exceed thirty (30) days, or be both so fined and imprisoned.

The above ordinance passed and adopted this 13 day of December, 1969, by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas.
