ORDINANCE NO. 121

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE OFFENSE OF ASSAULTING AN OFFICER IN DISCHARGE OF DUTY, MAKING THE SAME UNLAWFUL AND PROVIDING FINE AND PENALTIES FOR CONVICTION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. Every person who shall knowingly assault, strike, beat or wound any public officer, his deputy or lawful assistant while in the discharge of any official duty shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not less than Five Dollars (\$5) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100), or be imprisoned not to exceed thirty (30) days, or be both so fined and imprisoned.

This ordinance passed and adopted this 13 day of December, 1969, by the governing body of the city of Andover, Kansas.
