ORDINANCE NO. 122

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE OFFENSE OF AN UNLAWFUL ASSEMBLY AND PROVIDING FINE AND PENALTIES FOR THE CONVICTION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. Any person who shall be one of three (3) or more persons to assemble in the city with intent to do any unlawful act with force or violence against the person or property of another, or to do any unlawful act against the peace, or being lawfully assembled agree with other to do any unlawful act as aforesaid or make any movement or preparation thereof, shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not less than Five Dollars (\$5) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100).

The above ordinance passed and adopted this 13 day of December, 1969, by the governing body of the city of Andover, Kansas
