ORDINANCE NO. 124

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE OFFENSE OF DISTURBING THE PEACE, MAKING THE SAME UNLAWFUL, AND PROVIDING FINE AND PENALTIES FOR THE CONVICTION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. Every person who shall willfully disturb the peace and quiet of any person, family or neighborhood, shall upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not less than Five Dollars (\$5) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100), or be imprisoned not to exceed thirty (30) days, or be both so fined and imprisoned.

The above ordinance passed and adopted this 13 day of December, 1969, by the governing body of the city of Andover, Kansas.
