ORDINANCE NO. 125

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE OFFENSE OF ASSAULT AND BATTERY, MAKING IT UNLAWFUL, AND PROVIDING FOR FINE AND PENALTIES FOR THE CONVICTION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. Any person who shall unlawfully strike, beat, maim or in any unlawful manner do bodily injury to another, or who shall in a violent, angry, rude or insolent manner touch or lay hands upon a person of another shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not less than Five Dollars (\$5) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100), or be imprisoned not to exceed thirty (30) days, or be both so fined and imprisoned.

The above ordinance passed and adopted this 13th day of December, 1969, by the governing body of the city of Andover, Kansas.
