
ORDINANCE NO. 126

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE OFFENSE OF ASSAULT, MAKING IT UNLAWFUL AND PROVIDING FOR FINE AND PENALTIES FOR THE CONVICTION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. Any person who shall attempt unlawfully to strike or in any unlawful manner offer to do bodily harm to another, or who shall unlawfully make an attempt to apply either directly or indirectly any degree of force or violence to the person of another shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not less than Five Dollars (\$5) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100), or be imprisoned not to exceed thirty (30) days, or be both so fined and imprisoned.

The above ordinance passed and adopted this 13 day of December, 1969, by the governing body of the city of Andover, Kansas.
