ORDINANCE NO. 134

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF AND AMENDING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 128 OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS; AND PRESCRIBING SCHOOL ZONES AND THE HOURS AND DAYS IN WHICH SPEED LIMITS ARE EFFECTIVE IN SUCH ZONES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Section 1 (b) of Ordinance No. 128 of the City of Andover, Kansas, as passed and adopted by the Governing Body of said City on the 14th day of February, 1970, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

(b) Main Street from the North line of South Street to the South line of the Kansas Turnpike Overpass.

Section 2. That Section 2 of said Ordinance No. 128 is hereby amended to read as follows:

" That no person shall operate a motor vehicle within the school zones established by said Ordinance No. 128 at a speed ~~not to exceed~~ ¹⁵ Miles Per Hour during the period of 7:30 to 3:00 ^{7:30 to 3:00} A.M. and 4:30 P.M., Monday through Friday of each week."

The above Ordinance passed and adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas, this 11th day of April, 1970.
