ORDINANCE NO. 136


AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 119 OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS AND PROVIDING FOR A REDUCTION IN THE SEWER CONNECTION FEE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 119 as passed and adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas, on the 13th day of December, 1969, is hereby repealed and amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. That hereafter any new connection made to the saitary sewer system of the City of Andover, Kansas shall not be made until the owner of the property shall make application to the City Clerk and pay a sewer connection fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) to said clerk."

The above Ordinance duly passed and adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas, this 11th day of April, 1970.
