ORDINANCE NO. 137

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING AND RE-DESIGNATING THE NAMES OF CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS

Section 1. That the following streets in the City of Andover, Kansas shall have their names changed and be re-designated as follows:

- a. The so-called El Dorado Street or 160th Street East shall, after the publication of this ordinance, be designated as Andover Road.
- b. The presently named Waggoner Street shall, after the publication of this ordinance, be designated as Thirteenth Street.
- c. The presently named South Street shall, after the publication of this ordinance, be designated as Waggoner Street.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall become effective after passage by the Governing Body and after its publication once in the official city newspaper

The above ordinance duly passed and adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas, this 9th day of May, 1970.
