ORDINANCE NO. 139

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING A CERTAIN PORTION OF SECTION 1, AND AMENDING SECTION 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 32 OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF THE BURNING OF GARBAGE AND OTHER MATTERS WHICH MAY EMIT OBNOXIOUS ODORS AND SMOKE, AND ALSO PROVIDING FOR THE PROPER SCREENING OF TRASH BURNING RECEPTACLES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. That portion of Section 1 of Ordinance No. 32 as adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas on the 8th day of September, 1962, prohibiting a tin garbage or trash can greater than thirty-five (35) gallons be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 2. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 32 as adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas on the 8th day of September, 1962, be repealed and is hereby amended to read as follows:

"It shall be unlawful for any person to burn or cause to be burned in the City of Andover, Kansas, any garbage which upon burning may emit obnoxious odors or smoke. It shall likewise be unlawful for any person to burn any trash in said city when the fire burning the same shall not be observed and kept under constant control by a competent attendant during all times when said fire shall be burning, and if left unattended, the same will be burned in a solid receptacle having a secure cover thereon with a mesh screen having no more than one inch mesh openings.

Section 3. That notwithstanding the amendments made in Section 1 and 3 hereinabove, all of the other sections of said Ordinance No. 32 shall remain in full force and effect.

The above Ordinance duly passed and adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas this 9th day of May, 1970.
