ORDINANCE NO. 144

AN ORDINANCE ENACTED PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY OF K.S.A. 12-3009 THROUGH 12-3012, INCLUSIVE, AND ADOPTING BY REFERENCE THE SO-CALLED SOUTHERN STANDARD BUILDING CODE AS ORIGINALLY ADOPTED ON NOVEMBER 16, 1945, AND AMENDED BY THE 1969 EDITION THEREOF AS WELL AS THE 1970 REVISION TO THE 1967 EDITION THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR THE EXCLUSION OF CERTAIN APPENDICES THERETO AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1) That pursuant to the authority of K.S.A. 12-3009 through 12-3012, inclusive of both section there is hereby adopted the so-called Southern Standard Building Code as originally adopted by the Southern Building Congress Board of Trustees in November, 1945, and thereafter amended by the 1969 edition thereof as well as the 1970 revision to the 1967 edition thereof, and such adoption shall be as complete as if the content of the said Southern Standard Building Code was fully set out herein, excepting, of course, those portions thereof specifically excluded therefrom.

Section 2) That there shall be excluded from said Code as follows: NONE.

Section 3) That any person, firm or corporation found guilty of violation of the provisions of said Code, shall upon conviction be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), and each day that such violation continues, may at the option of the City, be considered a separate violation of said code.

Section 4) That the City Clerk of said City shall comply with the provisions of K.S.A. 12-3010 by marking official copies of said Code in the manner prescribed by said statute and make the same available in the manner prescribed in said statute.

The above ordinance duly passed and adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas, this 27<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1970.
