ORDINANCE NO. 151

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT UNLAWFUL TO BE IN A DRUNKEN CONDITION IN CERTAIN PLACES AND UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS IN THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. That from and after the enactment and publication of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person to be drunk or in a drunken condition on any street or in any public place in the City of Andover, Kansas, or for any person in his own house or anyplace in the City and disturbing his family or others.

Section 2. Any person found guilty of the violation of the provision of this ordinance shall be fined a sum not to exceed \$100.00 or imprisoned not to exceed 30 days, or both such fine and imprisonment.

The above ordinance duly passed and adopted by the Governing Body of the City Andover, Kansas, this 9<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1971.
