ORDINANCE NO. 154

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND AMENDING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 119 AND SECTION NO. 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 136 OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, AND PROVIDING FOR A CHANGE IN THE SEWER CONNECTION FEE AND RESERVING THE OTHER PORTIONS OF SAID REPEALED AND AMENDED SECTION AND DEFINING THE NATURE OF A SEWER CONNECTION, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR ANY PERSON, FIRM OR CORPORATION FAILING TO COMPLY WITH THE TERMS OF THIS ORDINANCE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. That Section No. 2 of Ordinance No. 119 as passed and adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas, on the 13th day of December, 1969, and reading as follows:

"Section 2. That hereafter any new connection made to the sanitary sewer system of the City of Andover, Kansas, shall not be made until the owner of the property shall make application to the City Clerk and pay a sewer connection fee of Fifty Dollars (\$0.00) to said Clerk."

is hereby repealed.

Section 2. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 136 as passed and adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas, on the 11th day of April, 1970, and reading as follows:

"Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 119 as passed and adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas, on the 13th day of December, 1969, is hereby repealed and amended to read as follows:

'Section 2. That hereafter any new connection made to the sanitary sewer system of the City of Andover, Kansas, shall not be made until the owner of the property shall make application to the City Clerk and pay a sewer connection fee of, Ten Dollars (\$10.00) to said clerk.'

is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That hereafter any new connection made to the sanitary sewer system of the City of Andover, Kansas, shall not be made until the owner of the property shall make application to the City Clerk and pay a sewer connection fee of \$20.00 to said Clerk.

Section 4. That for the purpose of this Ordinance each separate use of the sanitary sewer system of said City by each separate dwelling unit or business establishment shall be considered to be a separate sewer connection and liable for the payment of a separate sewer connection charge.

Section 5. Any person, firm or corporation, being the owner of property or otherwise responsible for making a connection to the sanitary sewer system of the City of Andover, Kansas, without first obtaining a permit as provided for in Section 3 above, and paying for this connection as provided for therein shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than \$50.00 or more than \$100.00.

The above Ordinance duly passed and adopted by the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas, this 12th day of June, 1971.
