ORDINANCE NO. 173

AN ORDINANCE ENACTED PURSUANT TO AUTHORITY OF K.S.A. 1971 SUPP. 12-3009 AND K.S.A. 12-3010 AND ADOPTING BY REFERENCE, THE MODEL CODE OR ORDINANCE KNOWN AS "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES, 1971 EDITION", AND PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN EXCEPTIONS THERETO AND PROVIDING FOR THE MARKING AND SUPPLYING OF OFFICIAL COPIES AS PRESCRIBED BY STATUTE AND PROVIDING A GENERAL PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1: That pursuant to K.S.A. 1971 Supp. 12-3009 and K.S.A. 12-3010 there is hereby adopted by reference the so-called "Standard Traffic Ordinance For Kansas Cities" 1971 Edition, as published and prepared by The League of Kansas Municipalities, the same as if said model or standard code were set out in full herein, except for those portions thereof hereinafter ~~ad~~mitted or deleted.

Section 2: That Sections 35(a), 35(b)(1),(2) and (3), 35(c), 35(d), and 35(e) shall be deleted from said Standard Model Code or Ordinance and previous existing speed limits as adopted by ordinance enacted prior hereto shall still be deemed to be in full force and effect.

Section 3: That all of Section 31 of said Model Code or Ordinance is hereby deleted therefrom.

Section 4: That the City Clerk of Andover, Kansas shall prepare and mark three copies of said Standard Code or Ordinance, by marking or stamping thereon, "Official Copy as Incorporated by Ordinance No. 173", with all sections or portions thereof intended to be omitted clearly marked to show any such omission or showing the sections, articles, chapters, parts or portions that are incorporated, as the case may be, and to which shall be attached a copy of this Ordinance, and filed with the City Clerk to be open to inspection and available to the public at all reasonable business hours.

Section 5: For all offenses under said Standard or Model Code where no specific fine or imprisonment is provided, the fine shall be not less than \$5.00 or more than \$100.00 and no imprisonment for more than 30 days or both

Section 6: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication.
