ORDINANCE NO. 181

AN ORDINANCE ENACTED PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF K.S.A. 1969 SUPP. 12-520 ANNEXING A CERTAIN TRACT OF UNPLATTED LAND LYING IN THE NORTHWEST QUARTER OF SECTION SEVENTEEN, TOWNSHIP TWENTY-SEVEN, RANGE THREE EAST TO THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, A MAJOR PORTION OF WHICH LAND IS ANNEXED WITH THE CONSENT OF THE OWNERS THEREOF AND THE BALANCE THEREOF BEING PUBLIC ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY, SAID PUBLIC ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY CONSTITUTES LESS THAN TWENTY ACRES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. That there is hereby annexed to the City of Andover, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 1969 Supp. 12-520, the following described real property located in Butler County, Kansas, to-wit:

Commencing at a point 50 feet North of the Northeast Corner of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Seventeen (17), Township Twenty-Seven (27), Range Three (3) East, thence West a distance of 1320 feet, thence South to the South line of the North Half ($N\frac{1}{2}$) of said Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$), thence East along said South line to the East line of said Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$), thence North along the East line of said Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) extended to the point of beginning.

Section 2. That the said land annexed in Section 1 hereinabove is annexed with the consent of the owners thereof excepting the North 100 feet thereof which is public road right-of-way and constitutes less than twenty acres, and is further annexed for the purpose of making the city boundary lines uniform and harmonious, and that said tract is so situated that the North boundary line thereof adjoins the present corporate limits of said City.
