ORDINANCE NO. 183

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE OPENING OF LAFAYETTE STREET FROM THE EAST LINE OF GLANCEY STREET TO THE WEST CORPORATE LIMITS OF ANDOVER, KANSAS; AND GLANCEY STREET FROM THE NORTH LINE OF LAFAYETTE STREET TO A POINT 15 FEET SOUTH OF LOT SIX, BLOCK SEVEN, GLANCEY'S RESERVE TO THE TOWN, NOW CITY, OF ANDOVER, KANSAS, WHICH PORTION OF STREETS WERE EITHER PREVIOUSLY VACATED OR CLOSED BY A CERTAIN ORDER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BUTLER COUNTY, KANSAS; AND DESIGNATING SAID STREETS TO NOW BE PUBLIC THOROUGHFARES AND WAYS OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, prior hereto, and by action taken on the 9th day of November, 1932 by the Board of County Commissioners of Butler County, Kansas as reflected in the journal of said County Commissioners at page 435B, the said Board of County Commissioners then and there, having apparent jurisdiction to close streets and alleys in the town of Andover, Kansas, did close the following streets, or portions of streets, within said town, to-wit:

(A)

LAFAYETTE STREET from the east line of Glancey Street to what is now the west corporate limits of Andover, Kansas, the same being 30 feet west of Lot 6, in Block 9, Glancey's Reserve to the town, now city of Andover, Kansas, and

(B)

GLANCEY STREET from its intersection of the north line of Lafayette Street to a point 15 feet south of Lot 6, Block 7, Glancey's Reserve to the town, now city, of Andover, Kansas, and

WHEREAS, notwithstanding such action by the Board of County Commissioners the said streets, or portions of streets, above named, as originally platted have been continuously used as public streets or thoroughfares since the said action of the Board of County Commissioners, and

WHEREAS, all of the streets, or portions thereof, above named are now within the corporate limits of the City of Andover, Kansas, and

WHEREAS, no structures or buildings, or other appurtenances have been erected upon the right-of-way of said streets, or portions of streets, as originally dedicated, and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of said City deems it necessary to make a finding and determination that said streets, or portions of streets, above named be public streets and thoroughfares.

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. That the streets, or portions of streets, referred to in the preamble of this Ordinance, which preamble by this reference is made a part of this Section as fully as if set out herein, are hereby determined to be public streets and thoroughfares in the City of Andover, Kansas notwithstanding the aforementioned action of the Board of County Commissioners taken on the 9th day of November, 1932.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its adoption and publication in the official City newspaper.

The above Ordinance passed and adopted by the Governing Body of Andover, Kansas, on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1973.


