ORDINANCE NO. 190

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING THE OFFENSE OF PETTY LARCENY, MAKING THE SAME UNLAWFUL AND PROVIDING FOR FINE AND PENALTIES FOR THE CONVICTION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS:

Section 1. Every person who shall steal, take and carry away any money or personal property or effects of another, under the value of Fifty Dollars (\$50) (not being the subject of grand larceny, without regard to value), shall be deemed guilty of petty larceny, and shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined in any sum not less than Five Dollars (\$5) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100), or be imprisoned not to exceed Thirty (30) days, or be both so fined and imprisoned.

The above ordinance passed and adopted this 14th day of April, 1973, by the governing body of the city of Andover, Kansas.
