ORDINANCE NO. 200

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES AND ASSESSMENTS IN THE CITY OF ANDOVER, KANSAS TO BE PLACED UPON THE TAX ROLLS AS TAXES AND ASSESSMENTS FOR THE YEAR 1973 PURSUANT TO THE BUDGET ADOPTED BY SAID CITY FOR THE YEAR 1974.

WHEREAS, Prior hereto on the 14th day of August, 1973, the Governing Body of the City of Andover, Kansas has approved, adopted and certified, after proper notice and public hearing, the budget of the City of Andover, Kansas for the year 1974, and

WHEREAS, the levy of taxes and assessments created by such budget should be made by ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE

Section 1. In conformity with the purpose aforesaid, there is hereby levied against the property both real and personal in the City of Andover, Kansas, the following levies for the following purposes as tax levies for the year 1973:

Ad valorem levies against all the properties in the City of Andover, Kansas for the following purposes:

1. General Fund	4.32 mills
2. Library Fund	.26 mills
3. Bond and Interest	7.69 mills
4. Social Security	<u>.63</u> mills
Total	12.90 mills

Section 2. In addition thereto there has prior hereto by ordinance been levied certain special assessments for paving and sewer districts specifically benefited by such paving and sewer.

The above Ordinance duly passed and adopted the 14th day of August, 1973.
